








York


Goodwood

Pattern / Size 60cm x random lengths x 2cm












Chester


Ludlow




Bath

Pattern / Size 60cm x random lengths x 1.5cm 60cm x 90cm x 1.5cm 90cm x 90cm x 1.5cm








Kelso

A selected travertine of mottled creamy beige, with tumbled edges, defines this characterful Flagstone Flooring as a perfect choice for any country house.



Worcester

A limestone very reminiscent of a Cotswold farmhouse flagstone flooring tile. A beautiful light honeyed colour, with a subtle variation, and some inclusions of fossils, makes this a natural Tumbled Limestone Flooring stone you'll never tire of. It is supplied in large format tiles, and sits comfortably in any traditional house.

Pattern / Size 40cm, 50cm, 60cm x 2cm x various Large Opus pattern x 2cm








Chepstow

The Chepstow limestone has a natural organic feel, that will add both a warmth and beauty to your home. It is a rich, creamy colour with variations in tone, and with seashells present in the tiles. A very natural looking stone tile.

Southwell

This classical flagstone flooring tile will recall visits to old pubs and church's where original flagstone floors are still present. It is grey in a classical old school way, traditional and timeless. The tumbled and brushed surface recreates a natural stone floor which looks centuries old.

Leicester

You may have to convince your friends this Leicester Tumbled Flagstone Flooring has not been laid for centuries already. The darker colour, and tumbled and brushed surface, exuding the passage of time and old world character, producing a farmhouse Flagstone Flooring similar to an original flagstone.

Perfect Look

Depending on the property, please find some recommended patterns for stone flooring below. The combination of different widths x random lengths can take away the mass produced, factory look, that some stone floor scan have, resulting in a more timeless floor.



60cm x random length pattern

Floors generally under 40m². The random lengths offering a traditional look without looking to busy.




50cm and 60cm x random length pattern

Larger areas normally used in new builds or older properties, where larger sizes are preferred because of the scale of the area being fitted (mix usually recommend 25%/75%).



Grand Opus Pattern

Created using 2x (60x90cm), 4x(60x60cm), 2x (60x30cm) and 4x (30x30cm) to produce a modern day flooring pattern.



40cm, 50cm, and 60cm x random length pattern

This is the most traditional of the patterns, and has been used for centuries, otherwise known as "random courses" with each row being a course (recommended mix 10%/15%/75%).
