

Simplicity of maintaining a stone floor

Stone flooring is surprisingly easy to maintain over the long term, but it is important to follow a few basic rules:

- Protect your stone floor with sealant
- Make sure the sealant is applied as per instruction
- Maintain using a stone floor cleaner
- Sweep, vacuum, wash occasionally

Things to avoid:

- Do not use a steam cleaner
- the heat will destroy the sealant
- Do not use supermarket cleaners
- the bleach in them will strip off the sealant
